## **POSTPONED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE**

- There will be no procession of Choir or altar party until further notice.
- There will be no congregational singing of service music or hymnody until further notice.
- The nursery will remain closed until further notice.
- There will be no offering of an adult forum or Sunday School until further notice.
- Bedside Communion within hospitals, nursing homes, and adult congregant living facilities will may be

made by appointment, and only under mutually agreed-upon terms.

## **EXPECTATIONS FOR PARISHIONERS**

- WEAR FACE MASKS: Until the Governor of New Jersey lifts his directive, those attending public services are required to wear face masks prior to entering the building. A small quantity of disposable masks will be available if you don't have your own mask.
- **BRING YOUR PERSONAL PRAYER BOOK:** To reduce the potential for spreading virus through commonly touched objects, all Book of Common Prayer and Hymnals will be removed from the pew racks.
- **PLACE OFFERING IN PLATE UPON ENTRY:** Parishioners are invited to leave their offering in the offering plate at the entrance to the Baptistry (ushers station) upon entering the church. No passing of the plate will occur.
- **USE HAND SANITIZER:** Please use the hygiene station established at the principal door for the sanitizing of hands with liquid hand sanitizer and the placement of face masks.
- FOLLOW USHER DIRECTIONS FOR COMMUNION: Families will be invited to receive the sacrament of the altar one co-habiting family at a time. When departing the chancel rail, communicants will exit though the sacristy door and into the Nave as the next family is being directed to approach.
- **COMPLETE CONTACT TRACING FORM:** As we are required by the diocese to maintain a list of attendees, in the event we must participate in contact tracing through the NJ Department of Health, you are encouraged to complete the Contact Tracing Form each time you attend worship. The form is found inside your single-use service sheet, and may be dropped in the designated basket found as you exit the church through the porch.
- MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING AFTER SERVICE: At this time, communicants are encouraged to *Go in peace to love and serve the Lord* upon articulation of the Dismissal (BCP pgs. 339-340). In interest of avoiding a queue within the Nave aisle and prolonged social contact, the rector will not greet communicants at the door. The outdoor Jubilee Garden will be open as the means of providing another avenue to our door and as an area to linger while wearing masks and observing the required social distancing guidelines.



s we progress, we will continue to monitor State and Diocesan directives and adjust accordingly. Any and all articulations of these parish policies and guidelines are sbject to change based on the latest expectations being communicated by the State of New Jersey and the Diocese of New Jersey.
